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This report reflects the findings of the observance of the new provisions to the Electoral Code in respect of:

- Legal and institutional practice for implementing the restrictions on state resources during the election campaign;
- The process of reporting and controlling the activities prohibited to the central and local officials;
- Legal acts adopted in violation of the prohibitions provided in the 4-month period before the elections;

The following report will reflect the findings of other restrictions during the election campaign focusing on the conduct of the state administration, the use of public assets and the restrictions on propaganda materials of electoral subjects.

Legal and institutional practice for implementing the provisions

Upon the start of the election campaign, on March 25, further restrictions of the Electoral Code became applicable regarding the use of public resources, the conduct of the state administration as well as the expenses for propaganda materials by the electoral subjects. In this new situation, considering even the increase of political activities, there was an added number of denunciations from political parties, NGOs and citizens at the interface of prohibited activities (<https://aktivitete.kqz.gov.al/>) and at the portal of denunciations (<http://kqz.gov.al/kallzo>) of the Central Election Commission.

According to the CEC official data, until April 25, a total of 95 denunciations were registered over violation of [Decision no. 9/2020](#) on the use of state resources during the election period. The State Election Commissioner has taken a total of 43 decisions on these reported cases by:

- Imposing 3 administrative measures/ fines (*case against the Director of Lushnja Cadastre and against the mayors of Tirana and Vora*)
- issuing 5 notifications over taking of measures (*to Tropoja Municipality for*

carrying out public activities in which the SP candidate was present - to Librazhd municipality and SP in Kamza for unfurling propaganda materials - 2 notifications to the municipal police for closing election offices near the SP Voting Centers in Gjirokastra and DP in Tirana)

- pointing out 24 completed cases without finding violations;;
- pointing out 11 cases for non commencement of proceedings (cases beyond CEC's competences)

The Commissioner's decision-making period has been quite hectic. It is worth highlighting that starting from April 2 to April 24, 36 denunciations received on both online portals of the CEC were reviewed, but as it can be concluded, the majority of them were not put under administrative review or concluded due to "failure to find violations of provisions of the Electoral Code".

Among the denunciations that have been ruled down are even those on concession contracts or PPP agreements for strategic investments such as ports and airports, approved in the last months before the elections, which have been justified by the relevant ministries as a continuation of the procedures initiated before the restrictions of the Electoral Code entered into force, as well as for which no special funds

have been made available.

It should also be noted that, during this period, the Complaints and Sanctions Commission (CSC) has maintained in force the Commissioner's administrative measure ([Decision no. 234 / 14.04.2021](#)) amounting to ALL 10.000, against Mr. **Gentian Picari, Acting Mayor Vora**, denounced by the SMI for the non-functioning of the official website of the municipality, leading to the failure to publish public places in the territory of the municipality with the intent to display of propaganda materials by political parties and electoral subjects (Article 79, point 1 of the Electoral Code). **This decision remains to date the only punitive measure against a senior official in the framework of the restrictions of the Electoral Code, remaining in force even after review in the CSC.**

As it was announced in the last report, the appeal registered on 10.03.2021 at the Administrative Court of Tirana, for the overturn by CSC of the **administrative proceeding against the mayor of Tirana, Mr. Erion Veliaj**, has not yet been considered. This court held two preparatory hearings for the case registered with no. 31138-01809-80-2021, in which the High Court has been asked for an opinion over the powers of the administrative court to review the case in question. The Electoral College announced earlier ([decision no. 2](#), dated 04.03.2021) the *"On the lack of subject matter competence to review this lawsuit request."*

As it was forewarned in previous reports, the concerns over the implementation of the restrictions of the Electoral Code due to evasive legal provisions, further reinforced by the mitigating adjustments of Decision no. 9/2020 of the Regulatory Commission at the CEC, but even the practice of further interpretations of the Complaints and Sanctions Commission (CSC), **undermined the mechanisms in disposal of CEC in order to play its role in controlling and enforcing the provisions on the use of state resources during the election campaign.**

Reporting of public activities








Senior central and local public officials are charged by the [Electoral Code](#) with the obligation to report in advance to the CEC their public activities in the 4-month period prior the elections. As of April 25, in the interface (<https://aktivitete.kqz.gov.al>) it turns out that a total of **1.229 activities have been reported by central and local public institutions.** The launch of the election campaign certainly increased the number of public activities and promotions of investments by public officials, some of whom were already in the position of the candidate and in competitive positions as compared with other political forces. Even during this period, the **CEC did not prohibit any public activity reported by officials**, as set out by the Electoral Code in cases where it is found that the activities constitute violations of established restrictions.

SETA's field monitoring

During this period, the SETA project has continued to monitor the promotional activities of government cabinet members and mayors in seven major cities of the country. These activities on the official websites of the institutions, local media as well as the profiles of these officials on social networks (mainly Facebook), were then cross-checked with the reporting data of these institutions to the CEC interface, to bring about an analysis of the progress of reporting process and some further recommendations.

With the beginning of the electoral campaign has been increased the number of public activities and investment promotions by public officials, some of whom acting in the role of political candidate. Under this new circumstances the reporting process by the ministers-candidates has turned into a bureaucratic process losing its primary meaning. The Prime Minister and some of the ministers (Finance, Education, Agriculture) have continued to report electoral activities such as meetings with party structures or various interest groups, activities which are difficult to categorize as public investment promotions,

for which prior reporting to the CEC is requested, or just meetings of the normal agenda of a electoral campaign. In the same vein, the mayors under monitoring, have held daily meetings during the campaign in the company of candidates, where there have been promotions of investments made by the municipalities. **The intensity of the campaign and the formats of the electoral meetings make it impossible to make a fair assessment of the extent of the activities reported by the monitored subjects.**

Monitoring of normative acts

Pursuant to Article 91, point 4 of the Electoral Code, the Normative Acts and Decisions of the Council of Ministers were monitored, which were published in the Official Journal for the March 25, 2021 – April 25, 2021 period.

The following result as decisions in violation of the Electoral Code:

- 1 decision of the Council of Ministers
- 4 decisions of Municipal Councils

which brings about **benefits or mitigation measures** for the four-month period before the elections.

More specifically, the adopted acts can be consulted in [Annex 1](#).

The report did not include in the list of decisions found in violation of the Electoral Code the decisions of the Durrës Municipal Council denounced by the Democratic Party, about awarded grants for the reconstruction of houses damaged by the earthquake in the pre-election period.

The Article 91, point 4 of the Electoral Code

defines the prohibition for: “... *proposing, approving or issuing legal or sub-legal acts, which provide for the provision of benefits to certain categories of the population, such as acts that provide for salary increases, pensions, economic or social support, reduction or abolition of taxes, imposition of fiscal amnesties, privatization or granting of assets or rewards, etc., unless the initiative is conditioned by a state of natural disaster.*” Based on this definition, the grants for earthquake-damaged dwellings are considered as disaster-related funds and as such not prohibited.

In the same vein, the interpretation of this provision of the Electoral Code in a facilitative way by the Decision no. 9/2020 of the Regulatory Commission, defining “*prohibited activities only when public funds have been recently made available for them*”, has annested any legal act or concession contracts approved in recent months denounced as misuse of state resources. In some recent decisions of the Commissioner regarding the denunciations for concession contracts in the pre-election period, it has been argued that the state budget for 2021 was drafted and proposed for approval by the Ministry of Finance in November 2020, actually before the entry into force of restrictions of Electoral Code (December 26). Of course, these doubts about a deliberate decision-making of the Council of Ministers and Municipal Councils to orient the votes, would have been easily avoided in case the decisions were adopted after April 25th.



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Recommendations

It is now clear that the role assigned to CEC as a watchdog of any violations of political entities and senior state officials in the pre-election period was not accompanied by the proper powers to conduct administrative investigations, increase of human resources and the adequate institutional support to avoid delays and discouraging of decision-making. It is recommended that these issues be addressed in future electoral reform or adjustments along with demonstrating a stronger willingness of political actors to avoid misuse of state resources.

Regarding the restrictions for the adoption of legal acts in the election period, despite the violations, the Assembly, the Council of Ministers and the municipal councils continue to commit the same violations. Even in the case of a CEC decision-making, it remains unclear whether it has the appropriate powers over these important legislative and normative institutions of a parliamentary Republic.

It should be noted that the restriction on the adoption of legislation and approval of concession agreements, remains in force until the formation of the new government emerging from the April 25 elections (probably until September). Continuing the adoption of legislation in violation of the Electoral Code by the most important bodies in the country, will produce a further decline in citizens' trust in the rule of law.

ANNEX 1 – Normative acts in violation of the Electoral Code

Legal acts and decisions considered in violation of Article 91, point 4 of the Electoral Code, prohibiting the proposal, adoption or issuance of laws or bylaws, which provide benefits for certain categories of the population, such as acts that provide for the reduction or abolition of taxes.

1. Decision of the Municipal Council of Tirana no. 50, dated 06.04.2021; “On the creation of fiscal facilities for businesses in the framework of measures to cope with the consequences of Covid-19 pandemic.”

- On the proposal of the Mayor of Tirana, the Municipal Council of Tirana, through this decision, has decided that all entities including bars, restaurants and hotels, classified as small businesses, shall be exempt from the payment of the tariff for occupying the public space for the period April-September 2021. Also, it decided to postpone the deadline for payment of local taxes and fees for all entities, until May 20, 2021.

2. Decision of the Municipal Council of Tirana no. 56, dated 06.04.2021; “On rent subsidy of some families in need who can not afford the free market rent.”

- On the proposal of the Mayor of Tirana, the Municipal Council of Tirana, through this decision, has decided to approve the rent subsidy for individuals / families, according to the list attached to the decision. The rent subsidy will last 1-year. The financial effects amounting to ALL **338,670** per month, will be covered by the housing bonus fund of the Municipality of Tirana.

3. Decision of the Municipal Council of Tirana no. 57, dated 06.04.2021; “On

rent subsidy of some families in need who can not afford the free market rent.”

- On the proposal of the Mayor of Tirana, the Municipal Council of Tirana, through this decision, has decided to approve the rent subsidy for individuals / families, according to the list attached to the decision. The rent subsidy will last 1-year. The financial effects in amounting to ALL **274,158** per month, will be covered by the housing bonus fund of the Municipality of Tirana.

4. Decision of the Council of Ministers no. 244, dated 21.04.2021 “On determining the amount of funding, in the budget of 2021, for religious communities that have signed agreements with the Council of Ministers” - Official Journal no. 64, dated 21.04.2021;

Through this decision, the Council of Ministers has decided the funding, in the amount of ALL 113 million, from the state budget funds, to financially support the religious communities, by funding half of the minimum budget salary for about 508 employees of these religious communities in Albania, as well as the funding of the construction of the tekke of Elbasan, etc.

5. Decision of the Municipal Council of Tirana no. 68, dated 19.04.2021; “On rent subsidy of some families in need who can not afford the free market rent.”

- On the proposal of the Mayor of Tirana, the Municipal Council of Tirana, through this decision, has decided to approve the rent subsidy for individuals / families, according to the list attached to the decision. The rent subsidy will last 1-year. The financial effects in amounting to ALL **396,882** per month, will be covered by the housing bonus fund of the Municipality of Tirana.
